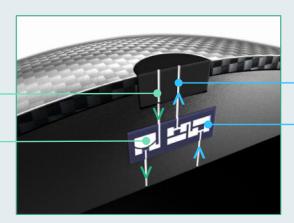


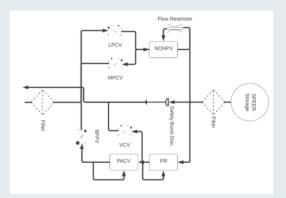


Main Component: HIGH-PRESSURE VALVE

It is a unidirectional normally-open valve that closes when, within a pre-defined range, the internal pressure inside the SFEER exceeds the external pressure.

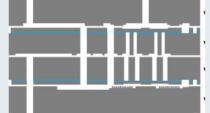




Controls the process to **release H2 gas** from the SFEER into the external **low-Pressure volume**.

PRESSURE REGULATOR

It consists of a cascade of several pressure control stages that successfully regulate the H2 gas from a maximum allowed pressure inside the SFEER into low-pressure outside.

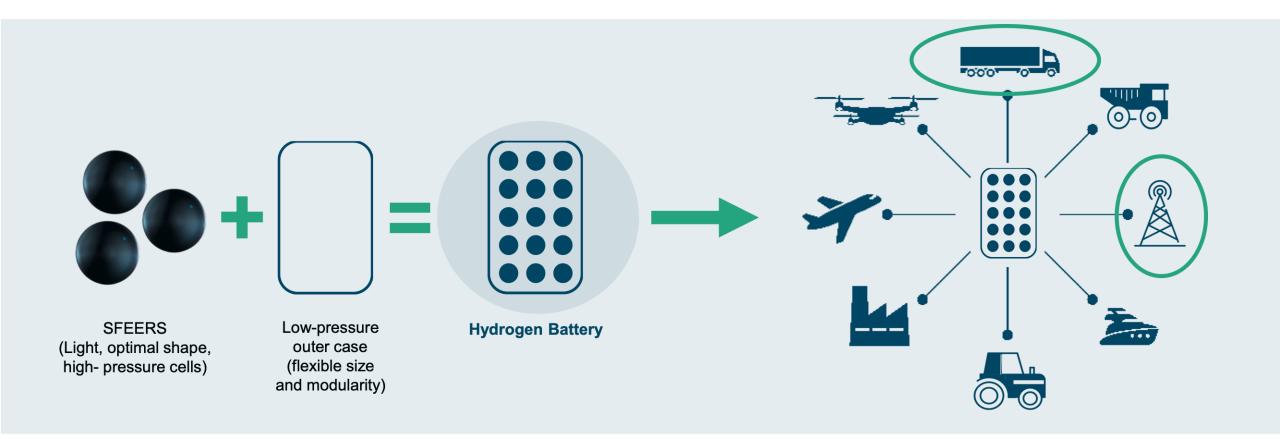

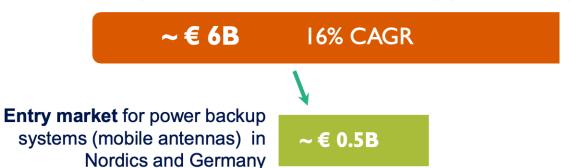
Revenue and EBITDA projections



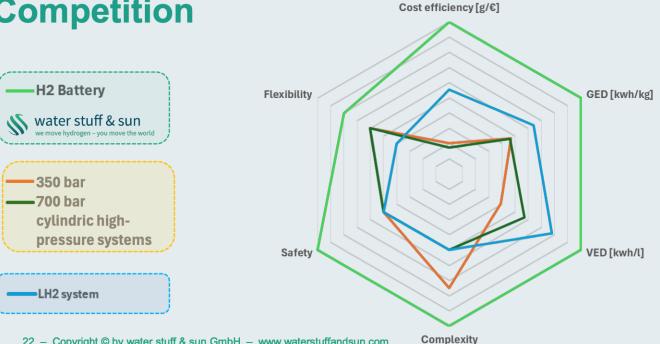
